Through Scan on Request, it is possible to request free scans of articles and chapters from the general physical collection.

You can make a request in the online library catalog by clicking on the option "scan on request" in the title description of the publication.

A safe visit

Despite the fact that the Rijksmuseum is allowed to open its doors again, there are still some basic rules that apply when visiting a museum.

- A proof of vaccination and ID card or passport are always required to enter the museum.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 meters.
